DISTINGUISHED TEACHER REVIEW

Below is the DTR eligibility criteria for the 2016-17 school year. Please note, meeting the 2016-17 DTR eligibility requirements and submitting a DTR application does not guarantee a teacher will earn a Distinguished effectiveness level. To earn a Distinguished effectiveness level, a teacher must also earn an average evaluation score within or above the Proficient II evaluation rating range.

Summative Score (2015-16 SY)	65 or above
Student Achievement & Student Experience Points (2015-16 SY)	At least 50% of combined points
Average Evaluation Score	Top 25% of teacher category <i>Category cut points available in September 2016</i>

2016-17 DTR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA For Teachers With <u>No</u> Prior TEI Data*	
COMPONENT	CRITERIA
Creditable Years of Service	2+ (in at least third year in 2016-17)
Summative Score (2016-17 SY)	65 or above submitted by December 6, 2016
In order to remain eligible to earn a Distinguished effectiveness level, teachers must meet the following criteria:	
Student Achievement & Student Experience Points (2016-17 SY)	At least 50% of combined points
